



Introduction

Welcome to our Bible Detective Series, a collection of Bible mysteries to be solved or decoded with lookups galore! It's a fun way to introduce children ages 6 thru 12 to beloved Bible stories, heroes, heroines and their evil counterparts. And solving mysteries will help them retain the answers! This package contains 50+ mysteries with scriptures verses and/or lookups in the following categories:

Solve & Color: 16 Bible characters show up masked on the pages (their names are not mentioned), but clues are given as to their identities. Students can solve in one of two ways: (1) descrambling the identities or (2)completing the Bible lookups in which the names are given. Then, the pictures can be colored in!

Become an Expert Bible Decoder: These 8 mysteries require decoding famous foundational scriptures using the English alphabet, but it's on a slide-rule principle, where one letter of the alphabet equals its counterpart, which is 18 letters up the scale.

Which Bible Hero: Kids will have to decode names of 8 Bible heroes using an alphabet that resembles hieroglyphics. If it's too big of a task, a Bible lookup is readily available to provide the answers. Then they get to draw the hero or heroine.

Solve the Labyrinths: 10 of these puzzles give important details of Bible hero's lives, and the job is to find the way through the maze. At the bottom is a new & unusual type of lookup. It leads students to the chapter and has them searching for the correct verse to finish a fill-in.

Sleuth out those Words: Is a unique word search that provides an important passage of scripture telling a detail about a Bible hero. Students must find the words that are bolded in the word search. They can then color in a picture!

Ways to Use this Package

The Solve & Colors can be used like lessons, where your students solve four a week for a month together. Cut out the pictures they color in and create a timeline on the wall!. Fill in the rest of class with one or two other mysteries, and provide prizes for the fastest sleuths (dollar-store magnifying glasses are one great prize).

Substitute teachers will love the ease of the package, making the filling-in easy. Students can do one of each to fill class time.

Start-of-class or pickup fun will keep minds active and fingers busy.

Just have a copy of the NIV Bible on hand with any use of these uses.

And finally, give pages as a gift or prize when incentives are called for! Moms and dads can look forward to becoming sleuths at home!

Once your students get started on this important Bible journey, they will be unable to stop! Start them now learning foundational Bible material in a way that all kids love—by solving mysteries.




Solve Labyrinth



Solve Labyrinth #1: Moses' Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. MOSES' problem was that he got mad sometimes. He killed an abusive Egyptian as a young man. While in the desert, God gave him clear instructions, but he got mad. He struck a rock with a stick when God told him to simply speak to it. The people were already mad, and his attitude didn't help! Go with MOSES from anger to **BEING AT THE TRANSFIGURATION WITH CHRIST,** when he was a shiny, sparkly being who came to hearten Jesus and the disciples.





Look up Hebrews II. Find the verse that goes with this famous faith passage about this hero:



Solve Labyrinth #2: Noah's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. NOAH'S problem was that he had a barge to build that was big enough to hold eight adults and hundreds of animals, insects, and birds for almost a year! God gave him explicit instructions, which he followed to the letter! It saved his family and all the animals. They got to start over again after the Great Flood. Journey with Noah as he cuts that first board to make the ark, up until his family emerged and he saw the rainbow!







Solve Labyrinth #3: Abraham's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. ABRAHAM'S problem was that God had made him a HUGE promise, if only he would move away from all he knew and go to a strange land-one filled with pagans! Abraham went on God's journey and got many rewards, including his son Isaac, who was the first direct ancestor to form the nation of Israel.







Solve Labyrinth #4: Joseph's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. Poor JOSEPH! He was Abraham's great-grandson, with 10 older brothers. The brothers were jealous because Joseph was their father Jacob's favorite. They had him sold into slavery and sent to Egypt. He started out as a slave, but soon became something akin to prime minister! God was with him, and the brothers realized it when they went to Egypt to buy food in a famine. Joseph the slave had become Joseph the very rich hero, bringing the whole clan and their families and all their servants to safety. Go with Joseph as he solves the labyrinth of his miraculous life:







Solve Labyrinth #5: Joshua's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. JOSHUA'S journey was full of tough choices. He was put in charge at the end of the Exodus, right after the death of Moses. God had given the people many miracles from parting the Red Sea to feeding them food that fell from the sky. But now that they were strong and courageous, God wanted them to take the land by might and force. Israel had to fight for its land. Joshua started with Jericho, when God made the walls tumble down. After that, Joshua had to face several fierce kings who joined together. Then he had to conquer 30-some tribes and nations! Go with Joshua as he goes from faithful follower of Moses to fierce warrior that conquered much land that made up Israel.







Solve Labyrinth #6: Gideon's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. GIDEON did not feel equipped to be a judge of Israel. He wondered at God's choice of him. But his faith grew as God went before him. Once God asked him to defeat an army so big it looked like "a swarm of locusts." Only God sent two-thirds of Gideon's army home first. THEN, he sent home most of the 10,000 remaining—except for a mere 300 soldiers. It was with this handful of men that Gideon defeated the huge enemy army. Follow Gideon has he goes through the labyrinth of not believing in himself to believing the God of Israel is powerful enough to lead him in destroying an army the size of a locust swarm.



Solve Labyrinth #7: King David's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. KING DAVID had a huge and unfair problem! He had just slain the giant Goliath. He was supposed to be crowned king, according to the famous prophet Samuel. However, the current king got jealous. After David risked his life, King Saul tried to have him killed! He had to run and hide in caves. He had faithful men with him. Some say David ran for 15 years! Follow David on his journey from teenager who killed a giant to the king who finally was crowned 15 years later.



Solve Labyrinth #8: Jonah's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. JONAH'S journey was-a bit wet and mushy! And very scary! Jonah didn't want to go to Nineveh and tell the people to repent. He was a snob and didn't think the people of Nineveh deserved God's attention. He fled on a ship. But God sent a big storm. Jonah got thrown overboard. He was swallowed by a giant fish! The fish spit him out after three days, and boy, did he hightail it fast to Nineveh! Go with Jonah from being a reluctant snob to being the prophet who helped God save Nineveh from a terrible destruction.



Solve Labyrinth #9: John's & James' Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. Here are two of Jesus' favorite disciples. But they could get upset. Jesus affectionately called them "the sons of thunder." They wanted to ask God to set fire to a town that had rejected the good news. Jesus told them to simply move on. These two became heroes of our faith. James was the first apostle to be martyred and John lived into his 90s, many say, and he wrote the book on "love," 1 John. He also wrote the Revelation, about Jesus' return that gives us all much hope. Follow James and John on their journey from hotheads to heroes for the love of Christ.





Look up Acts 12. Find the verses that record the killing of Jesus' beloved apostle James, the first apostle to be martyred.


He had James, the brother of John, put to death with the sword. When he saw that this met with approval among the Jews, he proceeded to seize Peter also.

Solve Labyrinth #10: Apostle Paul's Journey

All God's people have problems to solve and to help them grow in faith! They are a little like labyrinths. SAUL started out as a scholarly Jewish leader, who couldn't stand the gospel! He even helped people stone the first martyr, a man named Stephen. Then Jesus blinded him, appeared to him from the sky, and changed his heart. Saul became the Apostle Paul, who wrote 14 epistles in the New Testament. Follow Saul on his journey from snobbish scholar to loving writer, whom we still read 2,000 years later.
